Lindsey Hicks is a 2000 graduate of Lebanon High School. Lindsey was a Parade All-American and part of the Nation's No. 1 women's basketball recruiting class at Purdue. She holds a bachelor's degree in visual communications design/graphic design from Purdue. In addition, Lindsey was an integral part of three Big Ten championships, advancing to the NCAA Tournament all four years and collected a national runner-up finish in 2001 at Purdue University.

After graduating from Purdue University, Lindsey played professional basketball for six years. During her professional career, Lindsey played in Finland, Denmark, Sweden and Switzerland where she was the Most Valuable Player of the Danish League, captain of the Swedish team and a winner of the Finnish Cup championship. Lindsey started her coaching career as an assistant coach at Morehead State University for two seasons. She spent the last two seasons as the video coordinator on Christy Curry's staff at the University of Alabama. Lindsey is now the assistant basketball coach of the Northwestern State University in Louisiana.

Lindsey said, "My experience as a student/athlete at Lebanon High School helped me a lot in preparing for the future. Going from high school to college can be a difficult transition. I was fortunate enough to have teachers, coaches, family and friends to help me during my four years in high school. I learned how important it was to stay focused on what is important so that you can ultimately reach your goals." Lindsey also said, "I really enjoyed growing up in Lebanon and I believe it did have a positive impact on my life. I had a tremendous amount of support around me from all aspects. The family feeling everywhere that I go is what I love still about coming back to Lebanon."
