V. Hearing of the Public –

- Josh Beckman – shared his findings and opinions on face masks laws being regulated as a medical device, whether the face mask mandate is legal, the vaccination participation across the county.
- Pam Albright – thank you to the school for being open all year, children’s risk for catching covid is very low, and schools that have forced masks have not fared any better than those who have not mandated them.
- Amy Johnson – Echoed gratitude for the schools being open all year and thanking the teachers, she shared her background in speech language pathology and her belief of the impact masks have on children in relation to language acquisition
- Savannah Shafer – Requested for mask mandate to end. She said the health department should not have the authority to mandate this.
- Kate Bowles – Thank you for standing up for the kids, masks infringe on student and family rights. Information was shared about Covid and the Spanish flu.
- Beth Levering – Expressed concern regarding wearing masks, and shared risks in relation to wearing masks.
- Christi Traster – Lebanon school nurse recognizes efforts to keep schools safe, but believes the masks cause fatigue and other psychological issues.
