## All Kindergarteners provide:

- Water bottle with a spill proof lid-labeled with name
- 3 glue sticks - jumbo size .77 oz
- 4 boxes Crayola crayons- 24 count
- 1 box sharpened Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- 1 small manual pencil sharpener with shavings lid
- 1 pair of headphones (No earbuds please)- please remove from box and place in clear baggie with your child’s name
- 1 backpack - with straps that your child can open/close independently and large enough to hold a pocket folder (no wheels please)
- 1 plastic pencil box -labeled with name
- 1 pair of solid color Fisker scissors, blunt tip
- 1 box of skinny yellow highlighters
- 1 box of low odor black EXPO dry erase markers- 4 ct
- 1 container of Clorox wipes

## Girls in each class provide:

- 1 box of Ziploc quart size baggies
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer - pump style
- 1 roll of paper towels

## Boys in each class provide:

- 1 box of Ziploc gallon-size baggies
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 package of baby wipes

Then, put all of the extra supplies inside of a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child’s name. Take headphones out of the packaging and place in a separate large ziploc bag with their first and last name clearly labeled on the front of the bag. Please bring ALL of the supplies to school with you on your scheduled conference day.** Also, you may want to stock up during back to school sales for extra items to replenish in January if needed. With your help, we can start learning and doing great things right away. We are going to have a wonderful year. See you soon!
