All children should bring:

- One large backpack, large enough to hold a pocket folder (no wheels, please)
- One change of clothes in a large ziplock baggie to be kept inside their backpack, labeled with your child's name on bag
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container/canister of disinfectant wipes (like Lysol, Clorox, store-brand)

If your child is not yet potty trained:

- A supply of diapers/pull-ups to keep here at school. If you choose to send pull-ups, we do request that you send the ones with the resealable sides. As we get low we will send home a note requesting more.
- A pack of baby wipes with your child's name on them
