

## Ms. O'Connell's Preschool Class Bowman Primary School 2023-2024

Welcome to Preschool! My name is Kelly O'Connell and I will be your child's teacher this year! This is my seventh year teaching in Lebanon City Schools and my 35th year teaching. I started my career in Northern Virginia where I taught preschool special education, kindergarten and first grade for 14 years. I moved to Ohio in 2003 and have been teaching in preschool classrooms in both Hamilton and Warren County Educational Service Centers and Wilmington City Schools until I joined Lebanon City schools in 2017. I have taught preschool for 5 years and Jump Start Kindergarten for 1 year here at Bowman. I enjoy reading, taking walks with my fur baby — Toby, watching movies and playing games.

You have received a letter from our school office with a parent/teacher conference time scheduled for mid-August. This allows us an opportunity to meet both you and your child in a quieter setting to get to know one another, as well as to complete necessary paperwork and explain our program.

- 1 **full** change of clothes (shirt, bottoms, underwear, and socks) in a gallon sized ziploc bag, labeled with the child's name on the bag
- Family picture to be displayed at school on a Meet My Family bulletin board

## If your child is NOT yet toilet trained, please also provide:

- Diapers or pull-ups that can be refastened If you choose to send pull-ups, we do
  request that you send the ones with the resealable sides. As we get low we will send
  home a note requesting more.
- UNSCENTED diaper wipes, 1 large container
- Clorox Disinfectant wipes, 1 large container
