Dear Second Grader,

I am looking forward to a wonderful year helping you learn! Be ready to read, write, and learn about many new things.

Here are some things that you can practice for a successful start in second grade:

- ❖ Be sure to read, read! Remember, the more you read, the more you know! Read by yourself, to a friend, or to a family member.
- Review the Words to Know list here: Words to Know
- ❖ Practice single-digit addition math facts (ex: 9+9) and subtraction facts up to 18.
- ❖ Count forwards to 120 starting from any number. Count by 2s, 5s, and 10s, too.
- Practice writing sentences with correct word wall words and conventions. A simple journal about what you did this summer would be a great way to reinforce your writing skills!
- ❖ The Bowman rules are that we are all "Reflective, Respectful, and Responsible."

The children in our class will also need:

1 spiral notebook (wide-ruled)

3 plain, plastic, two-pocket folders with prongs (purple, green, & yellow)

- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 individual pencil sharpener
- 2 pink erasers

Hello, parents! In order to make your child's first day of school a smooth and easy one, please help by making sure his/her supplies are ready to use. Please take all of the supplies out of the packaging, and sharpen at least 6 of the pencils ahead of time. Place 1 pink eraser, 1 box of crayons, 1 dry erase marker, 1 highlighter, 2 glue sticks, and the scissors inside the supply box. Please put all of the remaining supplies inside of a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. Please take your child's headphones from the packaging and put them in a separate gallon Ziploc bag with his/her name on it. *Bring ALL of the supplies to school with you on your scheduled conference day.* You may also want to stock up during back-to-school sales for extras to replenish in January. With your help, we can start learning and doing great things right away! We are going to have a wonderful year. See you soon!
