Dear First Grader,

I can't wait to meet you! We are going to have so much fun learning this year and you will make new friends. See you soon!

Here are some things that you can practice to help you be ready for first grade:

- · Tie your shoes/zip and button clothing
- · Write your first and last name with capital and small letters
- · Say your full address
- · Count to 100
- · Write your numbers from 1 to 20 (no reversals)
- · Practice addition and subtraction facts to 5
- · Say the days of the week starting with Sunday
- · Write your ABC's in capital and lowercase
- · Practice the sounds of all of the letters
- · Practice reading these words: First Grade Words

Here is the link to the supplies that all first graders will need to have when they start school: <u>BOWMAN SUPPLY LISTS: K-2</u> *If your child prefers earbuds, that's ok with me. Sheanshang's students <u>DO NOT need baggies</u> or <u>hand sanitizer</u>. Boys and girls should each bring disinfectant wipes.

Students in our class will also need:

One 3 ring binder-1 ½ inch (any color)

1 manual pencil sharpener (needs to fit inside supply box with other supplies) Crayola broad tip markers in classic colors (this is optional)

24 Count Twistable Crayola Crayons (Prefered over the 3 traditional boxes)

Hello parents! In order to make your child's first day of school a smooth and easy one, please help by making sure his or her supplies are ready to use. Take <u>all of the supplies</u> out of the packaging. Sharpen one dozen #2 pencils ahead of time. Place 1 box of crayons, 1 pink eraser, 3 sharpened pencils, scissors and 2 glue sticks inside of the supply box. Then, put all of the extra supplies inside of a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. Please put headphones or earbuds in a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. **Bring ALL of the supplies to school with you on your scheduled conference day.** With your help, we can start learning and doing great things right away! We are going to have a wonderful year. See you soon!
