Dear First Grader,

We are looking forward to a wonderful year helping you learn! Be ready to read, write and learn about many new things. As a reminder, your child will have two teachers this year. Mrs. Evans will teach language arts and social studies, and Señora Seda will teach math and science in Spanish.

Here are some things that you can practice to help you be ready for first grade Spanish Immersion:

- Tie your shoes/zip and button clothing
- Write your first and last name with capital and small letters
- Say your full address
- Count to 100
- Write your numbers from 1 to 20 (no reversals)
- Practice addition and subtraction facts to 10
- Say the days of the week starting with Sunday
- Write your ABC's in capital and lowercase
- Practice the sounds of all of the letters

Practice these greetings in Spanish:

- “buenos días” ~ Good Morning
- “hola” ~ Hello
- “como estás” ~ How are you?
- “mi nombre es...” ~ My name is...
