

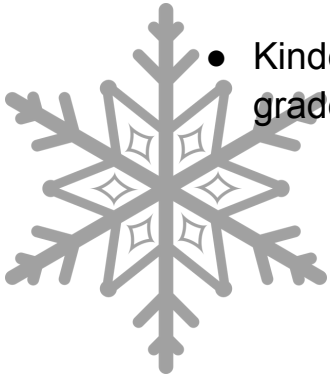


# Bowman School Delay Schedule



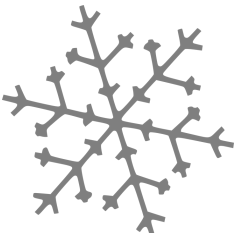
## Preschool and Kindergarten

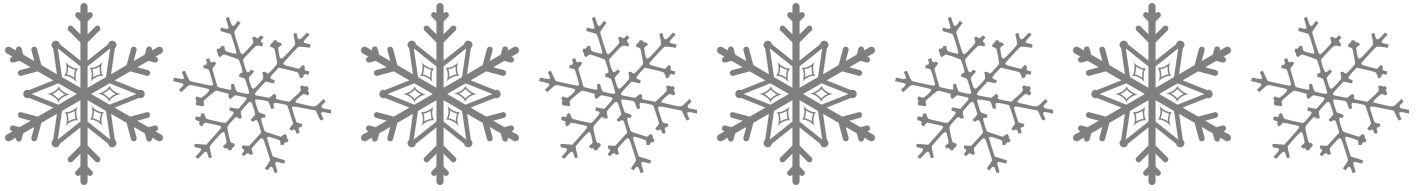
- In the event of a 2 hour delay there will be NO AM Preschool or Kindergarten. PM Preschool and Kindergarten will report at their regular start time in the afternoon.
- Buses will run as scheduled in the afternoon.
- Kindergarten EL students will report to school with 1st and 2nd graders on the delay schedule.

Dear Caregivers,

As winter approaches it is once again time to communicate our plans for informing our families about school delays and closures.

If the school is delayed or cancelled we will send out a text message to all caregivers/students/staff who have given their phone numbers to us. We will not be sending a phone call. If you prefer not to use text or do not have a cell phone, please utilize the other forms of communication we will use on these days.

Delays and cancellations will be posted to the school website and the school's Facebook page. You can also check the Cincinnati news stations and cincy.com for updates as well.

Please follow these directions to receive the snow day text message.

- Log into your ProgressBook account. (Please contact your grade level secretary for a Parent Access Key for ProgressBook if you do not have one)
- On the left hand side, click "Student Contacts." Information for the text notification contact will display.
- Click "Edit" to enter your preferred phone number for text notifications.
- In the (Phone) section, enter up to **2** phone numbers for notifications. Do not add more than **2** numbers as they will not be utilized.
- Click "Save"

**Note:** *Please do not make changes to any other section. Changes made here will not affect your student's primary contact information.*

A lot of factors go into making the decision about keeping the school open, delaying the start time, or closing for the day. The safety of our students and staff is a top priority. Those days typically begin around 4am and we must make our decision by 5:30am to make sure that none of our buses are on the road. We are in communication with local law enforcement regarding road conditions, our local snow plow drivers who are treating the roads, and with other local school districts. We also closely monitor the weather forecast for our area. Our final consideration is whether the parking lots and sidewalks are safe for travel.
