Dear Caring Adult,

In order to make your child's first day of school a smooth and easy day, please help by making sure his/her supplies are ready to use. <u>Take all of the supplies out of the packaging. Sharpen all your child's #2 pencils ahead of time. Place scissors, 1 dry erase marker, 1 box of crayons, 1 highlighter, 1 glue stick, and 3 pencils inside of the pencil box and write your child's name on the box. Then, put all of the extra supplies inside of a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. Take headphones out of the packaging and place in a separate large ziploc bag with their first and last name clearly labeled on the front of the bag. Please bring ALL of the supplies to school with you on your scheduled conference day.</u> Also, you may want to stock up during back to school sales for extra items to replenish in January if needed.
