Lebanon's Goals

End of grade 3- NOVICE HIGH

End of grade 6- INTERMEDIATE LOW

End of grade 8- INTERMEDIATE MID

End of grade 12- approaching ADVANCED LOW

Guidance from the World Language team at ODE:

Students should attain Novice High in most mode/skill combinations by grade 3 (because we do not begin until grade 1). By grade 6, students minimally should be at Intermediate Low. By 8th grade they should be at Intermediate Mid and by graduation, those that stick with it all twelve years should be at or approaching Advanced Low.
