



Drop-Off and Pick-up Procedures

To make for a smooth drop-off and pick-up of students at Donovan please follow these guidelines:

Drop-off

1. Student drop-off begins at 9:00. Students will remain in their cars until 9:00.
2. Follow the directions given by district staff members that will be out directing traffic in the parking lot.
3. If you plan to park and walk your child to the building, please turn left at the end of the entranceway and find the nearest parking spot. Walk with your child through the parking lot to the crosswalk located in front of the building.
4. If you plan to drop your child at the sidewalk please turn right at the end of the entrance before entering the main parking area. Turn left at the end of the lot and then left again at the sidewalk.
5. Pull forward as much as you can and have your child exit on the curbside of the car.
6. Do not block the crosswalk or handicap access ramp.
7. All cars next to the sidewalk will drop off students at the same time and then exit the parking.
8. The next group of cars will pull forward along the sidewalk and drop off the students.
9. All students must enter and exit the building through the main entrance.
10. Turn RIGHT onto Justice Drive during drop-off and pick-up times. This will help with traffic flow.

Pick-up

1. Car riders will be dismissed at 3:55.
2. Follow the same driving directions as for drop-off.
3. Parents are welcome to park and meet their child at the sidewalk or crosswalk area.
4. If you plan on staying in your car at pick-up please follow directions given by district staff members.
5. Students will walk on the sidewalk and meet you at the vehicle. Students should enter the vehicle on the curbside of the car.
6. Do not block the crosswalk or handicap access ramp.
7. Turn RIGHT onto Justice Drive during drop-off and pick-up times. This will help with traffic flow.

Student Expectations

- Follow the directions of staff members.
- Cross at the crosswalk when a parent or caregiver and staff member are present.
- During dismissal, stand on the sidewalk facing the line of cars.
- During dismissal, keep hands, feet, and other objects to yourself.
- During dismissal, look for a parent or caregiver at the crosswalk or for the parent or caregiver's vehicle.
- At dismissal, follow your vehicle until it stops.
