Bring: #2 pencils and a calculator. Every question can be solved without a calculator; However, we suggest you bring one with which you are familiar. **You are NOT permitted to use a cell phone calculator.**

What is the Local ACT?

This test is designed to give students an accurate assessment of where they currently stand in relation to taking the official ACT test. The results of this test may be used to plan future course scheduling, determine areas of need before taking the ACT, and help provide information related to college and career planning and interests.

PSAT - Some 10th graders and Some 11th graders (based on course enrollment)

What is the PSAT?

The Preliminary SAT/**National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test** (PSAT/NMSQT) is a program cosponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). It's a standardized test that provides first hand practice for the SAT®. It also gives you a chance to enter NMSC scholarship programs and gain access to college and career planning tools. The scores are official for 11th graders. This is a practice test for 10th graders.

Pre-ACT -- 9th graders and Some 10th graders (based on course enrollment)

This test is an assessment tool that provides information on a student's path towards college and career readiness standards as measured by the ACT. This data can help students, parents, and school personnel plan future curriculum choices and learning paths that best address a student's individual needs and goals.
