## **SCHEDULING FOR THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR**

Believe it or not, the registration and scheduling classes for next school year is well underway. Our counselors have finished their individual student meetings and are beginning to compile all of the information. This compilation determines what classes we offer, when we offer them, and staffing. Making the right scheduling decisions now is imperative because **MAY 10 IS THE DEADLINE FOR SCHEDULE CHANGES**. Students will receive periodic reminders throughout the spring, and they will also receive a printout of courses they have requested. If you have any questions about the scheduling process or timeline, contact your counselor. **Please be thoughtful selecting courses and remember schedule changes will not be made after May 10!**

## **ADVANCED PLACEMENT**

At LHS we continue to offer a variety of Advanced Placement classes and are very excited with the turnout for the AP night in January. Our goal was to inform parents and students alike the offerings, rigor, and expectations involved in the AP program. This a challenging and sometimes difficult college curricula. Please give this decision careful consideration, as you will not be permitted to drop any AP classes after May 10<sup>th</sup>. If you are hoping to take an AP class next school year and were unable to make the informational meeting, please contact your counselor.

## **ACT DAY - March 12 (Make up)**

On March 12 LHS will be administering the ACT to all juniors in the Class of 2019 as mandated by the Ohio Department of Education. We were able to create a schedule to allow the best testing environment for all of our juniors. As a result, **school will ONLY be in session for 11th grade on March 12**. 9th, 10th, and 12th graders will not report to school this day and they will all have assignments to be completed from home. WCCC 11th graders will be transported to LHS where they will take the test with their classmates.

## **NO MORE PAPER REPORT CARDS**

PLEASE REMEMBER: Lebanon City Schools no longer issues paper copies of report cards to students. All report cards and the most current grades can be accessed through ProgressBook (if school fees are paid in full or you have a payment plan set up). Please contact the school if you need help setting up your account or if you need to make payments on your school fees.

## **GAPQUEST - April 10**

On Wednesday April 10, we will meet with the senior class to discuss details around graduation. Following this meeting, we will host our 3rd GapQuest. GapQuest is for graduating seniors who are still uncertain on post secondary plans, who are considering taking a Gap Year, or who are looking for immediate employment following graduation. We will have many local businesses and post secondary opportunities in this job fair environment.

## **TESTING**

Beginning with the graduating Class of 2018, the Ohio Department of Education instituted End of Course (EOC) tests required to be taken at the conclusion of 7 courses (English I, English II, Alg I, Geometry, Biology, US History, and US Government). With these tests, students will receive points on a 1-5 scale and must reach 18 “graduation points” in order to be eligible for graduation. Of those 18 points, 4 must be in Math, 4 in English, and 6 in Social Studies/Science. We will begin our spring EOC testing the week of April 8th and will run different schedules on those days. We try to continuously put our students in the best testing environment as possible, all while trying to minimize the number of instructional days impacted.

## **FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE**

**Attention 11<sup>th</sup> grade Parents/Guardians:** The Ohio Department of Health requires immunization with the Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine **before entry to 12<sup>th</sup> grade**. Your student may have already received one dose of this vaccine, but a second dose must be administered on or after the 16th birthday. If the first dose of meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine was administered after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. If your student has not had these immunizations, please make arrangements for them to receive these as soon as possible. **Proof of immunization or opt-out must be provided to the nursing office by September 3, 2019, or by Ohio law, your student will be excluded from school.**

**\*Additionally, per Ohio Revised Code and school board policy, a student may also be exempted from immunization if a parent or guardian objects for good cause, including religious conviction. (updated 3/11/2019)**
