\*\* If they don't have a medical card then they should go to the Warren County Health Clinic, **513-695-1228**. They have very minimal fees that can be paid in installments if necessary. If a family does have a medical card then they need to check which group they are with. Amerigroup, Molina, or Care Source then talk to their caseworker or call the phone number on the medical card to see which doctors in Lebanon accept their group. There are also online directories for Molina, etc. but sometimes they are dated so calling the number on the card will give the most up to date info.

### **Pregnant Women and Young Children**

Women, infants and children eligible for the program receive coupons which enable them to receive milk, eggs, cereal, 100% juice, whole grains, fruits and vegetables, peanut butter or beans and infant formula from participating grocery stores.

#### **Head Start 695-2215**

This program is a preschool program for children ages 3 and 4. Children may attend as soon as they turn 3 years old. They do not have to be potty trained. The family must be at income poverty level. Children do not have to be citizens to enroll or attend. An application must be filled out. It can be accessed on line at [www.wccsi.org](http://www.wccsi.org) under the programs and services tab. Head Start welcomes children who may be experiencing delays or disabilities.
