

Drop-Off and Pick-up Procedures

To make for a smooth drop-off and pick-up of students at Donovan, please follow these guidelines:

Drop-Off:

- 1. Student drop-off begins at **9:00 AM**. Students will remain in their cars until 9:00.
- 2. **Students are not to be left unattended at any time**, including outside the building or near the crosswalk, before staff supervision begins.
- 3. Follow the directions given by district staff members directing traffic in the parking lot.
- 4. If you plan to park and walk your child to the building, please turn **left** at the end of the entrance way and find the nearest parking spot. **Walk with your child** through the parking lot to the crosswalk located in front of the building.
- 5. If you plan to drop your child at the sidewalk, please turn **right** at the end of the entrance before entering the main parking area. Turn **left** at the end of the lot and then **left** again at the sidewalk.
- 6. Pull forward as much as you can and have your child exit on the **curbside** of the car.
- 7. Do not block the crosswalk or handicap access ramp.
- 8. All cars next to the sidewalk will drop off students at the same time and then exit the parking lot.
- 9. The next group of cars will pull forward along the sidewalk and drop off the students.
- 10. All students must enter and exit the building through the **main entrance**.
- 11. Turn **right** onto Justice Drive during drop-off and pick-up times. This will help with traffic flow.

Pick-Up:

- 1. Car riders will be dismissed at **3:55 PM**.
- 2. Follow the same driving directions as for drop-off.
- 3. Parents are welcome to park and meet their child at the sidewalk or crosswalk area.
- 4. If you plan on staying in your car at pick-up, please follow directions given by district staff members.
- 5. Students will walk on the sidewalk and meet you at the vehicle. Students should enter the vehicle on the **curbside** of the car.
- 6. **Students are not permitted to wait alone at the crosswalk** or in the parking lot. A caregiver or designated adult must be present before students leave the sidewalk.
- 7. Turn **right** onto Justice Drive during drop-off and pick-up times. This will help with traffic flow.

Student Expectations:

- Follow the directions of staff members.
- Cross at the crosswalk only when a caregiver and staff member are present.
- During dismissal, stand on the sidewalk behind the red line and face the line of cars.
- Keep hands, feet, and other objects to yourself.
- Look for your caregiver at the crosswalk or your caregiver's vehicle.
- Follow your vehicle until it stops before entering.
